Justin D. Taylor Director of Engineering

Justin D. Taylor is the director of Engineering for the Defense Commissary Agency, with headquarters at Fort Gregg-Adams, Virginia. He is responsible for the planning, programming, design, construction, maintenance and repair of commissary facilities worldwide. His appointment was effective Dec. 31, 2023.

Before joining DeCA, Mr. Taylor served since May 2017 as the senior program manager for the Federal Bureau of Investigation in Washington, D.C. There he managed tenant improvement design and construction activities such as the major renovation of the FBI Field Office in Philadelphia. The project cost an estimated \$103 million. Other projects included managing the new \$45-million FBI Field Office in Columbia, S.C., and serving as FBI lead for coordination with the General Services Administration, design team, general contractor and FBI field office staff for programming and design of tenant improvement renovation and security for a \$15 million upgrade project in Anchorage, Alaska.

From May 2015 to April 2017, Mr. Taylor served as the senior program manager for the FBI HQ Consolidation Program Management Office in Washington, D.C., where he was responsible for programming, financing, planning and execution to design and construct a 11,000-seat facility sized at over 2 million square feet.

From March 2014 to May 2015, Mr. Taylor served as the construction executive for the Department of State, Overseas Buildings Operations in Washington, D.C., where he was responsible for planning, coordinating and directing construction projects overseas. There, he was responsible for the Pakistan portfolio consisting of five construction projects with total project costs ranging from \$1 billion to \$20 million.

Mr. Taylor also served in various other jobs from 2004 to 2014, including as a supervisory facilities program manager with the FBI in Washington, D.C.; a supervisory project manager at Tetra Tech Facilities Construction in Alexandria, Virginia; and a senior project manager for MBP Construction Engineering in Columbia, Maryland.

Mr. Taylor served in the Army from 1998 to 2004, leaving the service as a Captain. While in uniform, he served in several engineer units to include duty with the 4th Infantry Division from June 2003 to December 2004, where he deployed to Iraq during Operation Iraqi Freedom. He deployed to Tikrit, Iraq, from April to June 2003 as an operations officer with the Division Engineer Cell. There, he was responsible for coordination and synchronization of engineer operations for a 30,000-soldier task force from multiple U.S. Army installations to northern Iraq. He also deployed to Baquba, Iraq, from July 2003 to April 2004 as a maintenance officer with the 588th Engineer Battalion, where he led 60 maintenance mechanics and managed maintenance operations for over 350 vehicles, and coordinated with Iraqi civilian construction companies to upgrade unit living quarters, power generation, power distribution systems and unit maintenance facilities.
