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NOTICE TO EMPLOYEES POSTED BY ORDER OF THE EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY COMMISSION An Agency of the United States Government

This Notice is posted pursuant to a Decision and Order by the United States Equal Employment Opportunity Commission, dated December 8, 2022, which found that a violation of Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, 42 U.S.C. § 2000e et seq. has occurred within the Agency's Defense Commissary Agency, Ramstein Commissary.

Federal law prohibits discrimination against any employee or applicant for employment because of the person's RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, SEX, NATIONAL ORIGIN, AGE, DISABILITY or RETALIATION with respect to hiring, firing, promotion, compensation, or other terms, conditions or privileges of employment.

The Agency's, Ramstein Commissary, Ramstein-Miesenbach, Germany ("Facility") supports and will comply with such Federal law and will not take action against employees because they have exercised their rights under law.

This Facility was found to have violated non-discrimination laws when because of an employee's sex and in retaliation for engaging in protected EEO activity, the employee was subjected to harassment resulting in a hostile work environment.

The Facility has been **ORDERED** to pay the employee compensatory non-pecuniary damages, require the responsible management officials to take training in the provisions of Title VII, and to restore leave taken as a result of discrimination.

The Facility will not in any manner restrain, interfere, coerce, or retaliate against any individual who exercises his or her right to oppose practices made unlawful by, or who participates in proceedings pursuant to, Federal equal employment opportunity law.
