Joel L. Lockhart Director of Supply Chain

Joel L. Lockhart is the director of the Supply Chain Directorate for the Defense Commissary Agency, headquartered at Fort Lee, Virginia, a position he has held since October 20, 2024. He previously held the position of director of the Logistics Directorate from March 12, 2023 to October 20, 2024.

As the agency's Supply Chain director, Mr. Lockhart exercises enterprise-level responsibility for global logistics and supply chain operations supporting 235 commissaries in 13 countries, including 8 Central Distribution Centers in the Pacific and Europe and a Central Meat Processing Plant in Germany, representing more than \$5 billion in annual sales and approximately 770 employees. He serves as the principal advisor to DeCA's Director/Chief Executive Officer and Deputy Director/Chief Operating Officer on all matters related to supply chain performance and accountability.

Mr. Lockhart served more than 26 years on active duty in the United States Army. Prior to retiring from active duty in 2015, he served in a wide range of tactical, operational, and strategic-level assignments, including service in Panama, Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, Iraq, and Afghanistan. Subsequently, he held senior roles as a defense contractor and Department of the Army civilian. Prior to his current assignment, he had served since September 2017 as senior supply management specialist in the Acquisition Logistics Policy and Programs Directorate, Office of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Army for Sustainment, ASA (ALT). There he was responsible for advising the ASA (ALT) leadership on strategies and resources necessary to execute supply management and property accountability policies, processes and procedures. Together, these roles span more than 38 years of professional service in support of the Department of War.

Mr. Lockhart is also a published professional author whose articles have appeared in *Army Logistician*, the Quartermaster Professional Bulletin, and the United States Warrant Officers Association *NEWSLINER*. His writings focused on property accountability, knowledge management, logistics systems integration, and warrant officer professional development, contributing to Army-wide dialogue on sustainment modernization and leader development.
