Adrianne D. Moore **Director of Engineering**

Adrianne D. Moore is the director of Engineering for the Defense Commissary Agency, with headquarters at Fort Lee, Virginia. She is responsible for the planning, programming, design, construction, maintenance, and repair of commissary facilities worldwide. Her appointment was effective June 14, 2026.

Ms. Moore also serves as the chief, Facility Sustainment Division, a position she has performed since December 2022, where she is responsible for facility maintenance and repair of 235 commissaries and facilities worldwide.

Before joining DeCA, Ms. Moore served with the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA), Defense Supply Center Richmond in Richmond, Virginia, as the chief of the Installation Management Division. In that position since 2017, she was responsible for engineering, construction, and maintenance of real property and equipment.

In June 2016, Ms. Moore became the chief of the Engineering Services Branch with the mission of the installation's facility programs such as sustainment, restoration, and modernization, military construction and minor construction. She was also responsible for facility management including master planning.

In July 2001, Ms. Moore became the chief of the Environmental Office with the mission to assure that functions are performed in a manner that safeguards the environment, employees, and the community and ensures compliance with applicable laws, regulations and policies, thereby maintaining readiness and enhancing support to the warfighter.

In 1994, she joined DLA as a general engineer in the Facilities Planning Branch and was responsible for environmental compliance programs such as air quality, pollution prevention and emergency planning.

Ms. Moore began her civil service career in 1989 as an industrial engineer, managing facilities engineering projects for the Naval Aviation Depot in Norfolk, Virginia.
